

How is the Summer program effective?

The summer schedule offers the advantages of good weather and more availability of certified teachers to staff the program. In addition, the children do not have the additional burdens of homework, sports schedules, and health issues. This results in a relaxed atmosphere of total immersion in learning to live their Catholic faith.

The summertime catechesis is not new to Catholics. The nationwide CCD program in the United States originated in great from summer religious education programs in rural parishes in the Northwest and Midwest. The majority of the parishes use the vacation program as a supplement to their regular school-year programs.

Not to be confused with Vacation Bible Schools that are held in many parishes each summer, the Catechesis and Formation Summer Immersion Program is staffed by certified catechists and volunteers, many who are classroom teachers themselves. The students must cover the same curriculum that the traditional programs do. Students are called upon to exercise their faith traditions throughout the program.
