Dear friends,

Over the past few months, our Vocation Chalice program has been virtual. *****Beginning in September, we will go back to the original way of picking up the vocation chalice at Mass.** Here is a reminder for the directions:

1. Go to the Sacristy prior to Mass to get the chalice from the drawer. It is on the left side under the sign in notebook used for lectors, Eucharistic ministers, and altar servers.
2. Let the priest know that your family is there to receive the chalice.
3. Place the chalice in its velvet bag on the credence table near the altar servers' chairs.
4. At the end of Mass, prior to dismissal, the priest will call your family up and will say a blessing and hand you the chalice.

Place the chalice somewhere in your home that will remind you to pray regularly. There is a prayer attached to the chalice or you may pray your own prayer. The following weekend please return the chalice to the Sacristy. No need to have it there before Saturday Vigil Mass because there are two chalices. So if you attend a Sunday Mass and the next family attends Saturday, there will be a chalice there for them to take home. If you are ever unable to take the chalice on your scheduled weekend please call the parish office and let Dee know. Thank you for praying for vocations.
